A Message from the President

Casa de Luz: Providing Hope and Support for LGBTQ+ Refugees in Tiiuana

Five years ago, I became involved with a small shelter in Tijuana that was founded by Irving Mondragon. Irving has led numerous caravans from Central America to Tijuana, with gay, lesbian, and trans individuals who fled their countries in fear for their lives.

It is disheartening to know that there are still 67 countries criminalizing same-sex relationships between men, 41 countries criminalizing same-sex relationships between women, and 12 countries that even carry the death penalty for such relationships. These countries include Iran, Saudi Arabia, Yemen, Afghanistan, Pakistan, Qatar, and Uganda.

At Casa de Luz in Tijuana, I have had the privilege of meeting many incredible individuals with heartbreaking stories of why they had to leave their families, friends, jobs, and countries simply because they were not accepted for who they are. Many of them have endured brutal assaulted or constant harassment by gangs or law enforcement.

After enduring a terrifying journey that often spans 2 to 3 months, these refugees finally reach Tijuana, Mexico. Irving had rented a home to provide them with temporary shelter while they search for food, sponsorship, legal representation, and, in many cases, medical aid. Witnessing the extent of Irving's dedication to this community left me in awe, and I knew I had to contribute and help in any way I could.

Three years ago, I was fortunate enough to purchase a property in Playas Tijuana, which has now become the permanent home for Casa

de Luz. With 23 bedrooms, we can accommodate up to 60 refugees. We have created a beautiful outdoor garden area and a spacious kitchen. Each private bedroom is equipped with a queen bunk bed, providing a comfortable and safe space for those seeking refuge.

Two years ago, we established Casa de Luz, SD, a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that now serves as the financial support system for the program in Tijuana. Our dedicated Board of Directors works tirelessly to raise funds and ensure that the monthly bills are paid.
