We recently had an influx of many LGBTQ Russian refugees, and we hosted a wedding for two of them: Sergei & Sergei. As the number of refugees at our home are consistently growing even though many are crossing weekly, we were in dire need of a bigger kitchen. Two weeks ago, we started construction on an outdoor kitchen. That will help us serve our houseguest better than our old kitchen. We also built a gazebo, so our guests are sheltered from the sun and rain and removed a section of concrete from a parking lot to start an organic garden.

All these projects take lots of resources. We are dealing with a significant shortfall and are hopeful that over the Christmas season we will find some generous donors that will help us replenish our savings so we can continue with our mission.

Casa de Luz SD raises money for Casa de Luz TJ so they can offer a safe haven for people who lived in fear of persecution because of their sexual orientation or gender identification.

Trans, lesbian, gay & bisexual people are fleeing from all over the world to escape "epidemic levels of violence" and threats by criminal gangs and security forces. Over 2,900 were killed in the past 5 years just in Central America.

These are the most vulnerable refugees entering the US.
